

Voluntary Release of Liability Due To Negligence

I understand that the Safe & Sound concert series is a private event held on private land, and that there are risks involved in my participation, even considering the safety guidelines developed by the organizers.

Examples of risks and possible injuries include exposure to and possible sickness from airborne illness, including Covid-19; damage to or theft from vehicles; injury from tripping on uneven or non-standard pathways; injuries related to weather and acts of nature; food-borne illness; injury at the hands of another guest, or wild or domestic animals; other injuries that might occur from driving, walking, and sitting on private land.

By signing this document, I acknowledge these risks, and I agree to release from liability the organizers, land-owners, volunteers, musicians, speakers, other guests, and anyone else involved in the Safe & Sound series. Specifically, I am giving up my right to sue or otherwise pursue legal action to compensate any injury, physical or otherwise.

This release does not extend to reckless or intentional conduct on the part of the organizers, but it does cover any injury short of that legal standard.

Additionally, I have read the **Safety Guidelines** for guests, attached, and I agree to abide by these rules.

Safety guidelines

Thanks for your interest in Safe & Sound. As the name implies, we intend this private concert series to be a safe way to experience live music during the Covid pandemic. CDC guidelines suggest that socially distanced outdoor gatherings are a relatively low-risk activity. But we need your cooperation!

1. Do not come if you feel sick.
2. The address is printed on your ticket. Google Maps will guide you accurately to our farm.
3. Please be aware that our location is on a very narrow gravel dead-end road. Please be courteous and observant while driving. Keep your speeds below 25 miles per hour on the gravel road.
4. Pets are not allowed. Children who are able to sit in place with your family are welcome, but must be ticket-holders.
5. When you arrive, you will be directed by signs and/or helpers to the parking area in a field.
6. You will need to walk from your car to the concert area. Pedestrian traffic will be marked in one-way lanes. Please maintain six feet of distance from other guests. If you have special needs of any kind, please email sapsuckersmusic@gmail.com at your earliest convenience.
7. The seating area will be painted with 6-foot circles accessible from walkways. Seating is first come, first served. Please allow blanket seating in the front.
8. Face coverings such as a mask or bandana are required at any time that you are moving around the farm. You may remove your face covering when you are seated in your 6-foot seating area.
9. Before and after the performances, and during the intermission, there will be opportunities to purchase food from the food truck, merchandise from the performers, and use the porta-potty. Please make use of the hand-sanitizing stations during these times and observe social distancing.
10. Except for the parking area, concert area, and walkways connecting them, all areas of the property, both indoors and out, are strictly off limits.
11. During the performances, please express your appreciation by clapping. Shouting, cheering, etc. will reduce the effectiveness of our social distancing practices, and we ask that you refrain.
12. At the conclusion of the performance, please follow the one-way walkways to your car and leave the area in your vehicle in an orderly fashion.
